AHMI Placement Services gave 600 students the opportunity to interview with nonprofit human resource executives from the Boy Scouts of America, Camp Adventure Youth Services, Commongood Careers, Girl Scouts, March of Dimes, National 4H Council, YMCA of the USA, YMCA of Metro Milwaukee, YMCA of Greater New York, YMCA of Greater Rochester, YMCA of Metropolitan Washington and American Humanics National Office. Over 163 interviews were conducted with 83 students from over forty academic partner campuses. Several students accepted internships onsite and follow-up will continue to track the placement of students in the coming months.
